English	Maths	Theme	Other Subjects	What you can do to help your child this term
<p>We will be reading Roald Dahl's 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. This will be a focus of much of our writing this term. We will also read 'The Story of Chocolate' written by Katie Daynes.</p> <p>Writing types to include: Instructions, information leaflets, persuasive texts, posters, descriptions, letters and imaginative story writing.</p> <p>Grammar and punctuation: Children will be continuing to use capital letters and full stops in their writing, as well as exclamation marks and question marks. We will also learn about singular and plurals and prefixes and suffixes.</p>	<p><b>Multiplication and Division-</b>Children will count in 10s and will make and add equal groups. They will learn about arrays and how to make doubles. Children will learn to share equally.</p> <p><b>Fractions-</b> Children will learn how to find halves and quarters of shapes, objects and quantities.</p> <p><b>Position and Direction-</b> Children will describe turns and positions.</p> <p><b>Place Value-</b> Children will count to 100, learn to partition, compare and order numbers as well as being able to say 1 more/ 1 less to 100.</p> <p><b>Money-</b> Children will learn to recognise coins and notes and will learn how to count these.</p> <p><b>Time-</b> Children will describe time using 'before' and 'after'. They will learn how to tell time to the hour and half an hour. They will write and compare time.</p>	<p>Within our theme 'Chocolate' we will be covering the following subjects:</p> <p>Geography- We will be looking at where chocolate is grown and where it comes from. We will learn how chocolate is made 'from bean to bar'.</p> <p>History- We will learn about the history of chocolate.</p> <p>DT - The children will design their own room in the chocolate factory. They will create a model of their room out of a shoebox. They will evaluate their creations.</p> <p>Art - We will create observational drawings of sweet packets/ chocolate wrappers using different media.</p> <p>Science - Children will observe the effects of what happens when we heat food e.g. chocolate. Children will predict, observe and ask questions through various experiments.</p>	<p>RE - Learning the Easter story.</p> <p>Music - We will play tuned and untuned instruments musically and rehearse and perform with others.</p> <p>P.E- Athletics and Rounders</p> <p>Computing - We will be learning about coding.</p> <p>PSHE- We will continue promoting the values of health and wellbeing through leading a healthy lifestyle.</p>	<p>Please see the homework project for this term.</p> <p>Watch the Charlie and the Chocolate Factory films.</p> <p><b>Extra Challenge:</b></p> <p>Read another book by Roald Dahl.</p>
