<p>This term we will learn the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. We will retell the story and then change the characters and key parts. We will learn about comics and we will create our own comic.</p> <p>We will also focus on many cross- curricular pieces of writing, giving the children a purpose to write. This will include, writing non-chronological reports, creating a plant diary and using non-fiction books to research another country.</p> <p>Within our Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling lessons, children will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To use the conjunctions 'and', 'but' and 'or' To use exclamations for one word only and for commands. Finding related facts Comparing number sentences <p>Number: Place Value</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Count forwards and backwards, recognise, compare and order numbers to 50 Represent numbers using tens and ones Give one more and one less than numbers to 50 Count in 2s and 5s <p>Measurement: Length & Height</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Compare length and heights Measure length using non- standard units Measure length using standard units (ruler to measure cm) <p>Measurement: Weight and Volume</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Measure and compare mass Measure and compare capacity 	<p>Within our theme 'Where We Live' we will be covering the following subjects:</p> <p>Geography- We will name, locate and identify the four countries in the UK and learn the names of the surrounding seas. We will also be researching another country and create a fact file comparing that place to Chelmsford. We will also be looking at maps and create our own map of the Three Little Pigs' Village.</p> <p>History-The children will discover Chelmsford's local history.</p> <p>DT - We will build structures using a range of different materials. We will develop a food vocabulary and try various foods from around the world.</p> <p>Music - The children will learn to play percussion instruments as a group.</p> <p>Art - We will be learning about a range of different artists.</p>	<p>Science - We will begin the term by learning about different materials. After half term we will cover plants. We will grow our own cress and record its growth in a diary. We will also learn about deciduous and evergreen trees.</p> <p>RE - We will continue learning about different religions and compare them to our own values and experiences.</p> <p>Computing - The children will be practising basic skills such as typing and mouse skills. We will create a presentation about another country. We will also be following and creating simple instructions for a computer to follow.</p> <p>PE- Gymnastics and Dance</p> <p>PSHE- We will continue promoting the values of health and wellbeing through leading a healthy lifestyle. We will be discussing the differences and similarities between people and learn to respect them.</p>	<p>Continue to read every day and complete the comprehension homework twice a week. Please can children now write out the answers to the comprehension questions (in full sentences) themselves.</p> <p>Help your child learn to spell their High Frequency words (test every Friday).</p> <p>Please read and sign your child's homework page in their homework folder.</p> <p>Additionally, please help your child to:</p> <p>Recall number bonds to 20.</p> <p>Recall one more and one less than to 50.</p> <p>Write digits to 50.</p> <p>Count in 2s and 5s.</p>
