<p>We will be reading and writing a range of text types including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Creating stories based on 'The Stone Age Boy'. ❖ Writing non-fiction texts based on our learning. <p>Grammar and punctuation: We will be focussing on carefully editing and assessing the effectiveness of our writing and suggesting improvements.</p> <p>We will also be focussing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Using a wide range of sentence openers to make sentences more interesting. ❖ Choosing nouns and pronouns appropriately to avoid repetition. 	<p>We will be covering a number of different areas of Maths including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Solving problems, including missing number problems, using addition subtraction, multiplication and division. ❖ Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. ❖ Measuring and comparing and finding equivalent lengths in mm, cm and m ❖ Calculating and measuring perimeters of shapes ❖ Measuring mass in g and kg and capacity in l and ml ❖ Recognise and use fractions of numbers and objects. 	<p>This term our themes in class 3 is Stone Age to Iron Age. Within this theme we will be covering the following subjects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ History - We will be exploring this time period and how artefacts have been discovered. ❖ Art- Creating cave paintings and colour mixing to create a Stonehenge silhouette ❖ Geography - We will be learning about the geography of the UK. ❖ D&T - We will be making our own Stone Age jewellery 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Science - Our topic will be 'Forces and magnets and 'Animals, including humans'. This will include types of nutrition, skeletons and muscles. ❖ ICT Skills - We will be working on spreadsheets and presenting data and typing skills this term. ❖ PE- In P.E we will be continuing to develop outdoor games skills with Mr Stanley and Gymnastics ❖ RE - In R.E. we will be learning about key figures, festivals, special places and stories in Hinduism and Christianity (Easter Story) ❖ MFL - In Spanish we will be learning about Foods and My Body ❖ Music- We will be appreciating and responding to a range of music. 	<p>It has been wonderful to see the class mature and develop their independence during the last term.
