<p>We will be reading and writing a range of text types including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Creating stories based on the Roman Empire ❖ Reading and responding to Roman Myths ❖ Writing information texts about the Romans. <p>Grammar and punctuation We will be focussing on carefully editing and assessing the effectiveness of our writing and suggesting improvements.</p> <p>We will be working through Grammar activities on a wide range of spelling and grammar rules.</p> <p>We will also be focussing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Using a wider range of conjunctions e.g. when, because, although ❖ Choosing nouns and pronouns appropriately to avoid repetition. 	<p>We will be covering a number of different areas of Maths including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Formal methods of Multiplication ❖ Measures ❖ Properties of shapes ❖ Capacity ❖ Consolidating our learning for the year 	<p>This term our theme in class is: Romans Within this theme we will be covering the following subjects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ History - We will also be learning about Boudicca and the impact the Romans had on life in Britain. ❖ Art/DT- We will be creating Roman mosaics and shields. ❖ Geography - We will be using our map skills to track the expansion of the Roman Empire over time. We will use the 8 points of a compass, 4 figure grid references, symbols and key (including the use of Ordnance Survey maps) to build our knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Scientific Enquiry- Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants Explore the requirements of plants for life and how they vary from plant to plant Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants ❖ Light Investigating reflective surfaces and length of shadows, explaining how mirrors work ❖ ICT Skills - Simulations, graphing Using and applying skills - making their own PowerPoint on The Romans ❖ PE- Athletics and orienteering skills ❖ RE - Islam: use the correct religious words to describe some important features of the mosque, describe how some religious beliefs, practices and stories are linked ❖ MFL - In French we will be learning about Our School, Food and Time ❖ Music- We will be appreciating and responding to a range of music, and playing some simple instruments. 	<p>As always it is important that your child reads every night and that they are regularly questioned on what they have read to help them improve their comprehension.</p> <p>They should practice and learn their times tables and using these to derive answers to division questions.</p> <p>If you have the opportunity (subject to what Covid restrictions allow) to visit the Oaklands Museum your child may find the display about Chelmsford in the Roman times interesting.</p>
