<p>Text types: We will be looking at stories which raise issues and dilemmas, stories from other cultures and reports and recounts from the past. We will writing fact files about rivers and mountains and compiling a book on what we have learnt.</p> <p>Grammar and punctuation: -To use subordinate and embedded clauses -Writing interesting sentences using descriptive language. - To use full stops, capital letters, speech marks and commas for clauses and lists.</p>	<p>Mental addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.</p> <p>Number and place value up to 4 digit numbers.</p> <p>Fractions, ratio and proportion</p> <p>Units and measurement - length and perimeter.</p> <p>Decimals, percentages and their equivalence to fractions.</p> <p>Statistics - collection, sorting, representation and comparison of data through the topic work.</p>	<p>This term our theme in class is: Rivers and Mountains</p> <p>Within this theme we will be covering the following subjects: History - Anglo Saxons, settlements and how rivers were used. Geography- Different rivers in the UK and around the world, how rivers were used in the past for economic purposes and recognising the different sections of a river.</p> <p>Art - Sketching and painting rivers, Artist study of famous landscape painters - Block printing on Saxon Pouches.</p> <p>DT- Make a lyre. Design and make Anglo Saxon coins and jewellery.</p> <p>Music- Singing Anglo Saxon songs.</p>	<p>Science Core: States of matter and Electricity.</p> <p>Scientific Enquiry: Investigate factors affecting evaporation.</p> <p>ICT Skills -Measure data, analyse and present this as the children take on the role of meteorologists. Newspaper report writing.</p> <p>PE:- Gymnastics. Hockey</p> <p>RE - Pilgrimages Food and Fasting</p> 	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>When reading, look at sentences with clauses. Continue looking at powerful verbs and adjectives. Discuss how the writer has used descriptive language to describe a setting</p> <p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Revise multiplication tables - speed tables to improve time for tests. Use TT Rockstars and Purple mash to improve timing for recollection and typing of times tables. Encourage your child to help you with weighing and measuring ingredients. Using pizza and/or cake are a perfect opportunity to discuss fractions!</p>
