Encourage your child to predict what might happen next in the story. Read non-fiction books and discuss its features and content. Explain unfamiliar words.</p> <p>Maths Revise multiplication tables: in order, random recall, rapid recall and creating word problems using multiplication, e.g. a tray has 6 eggs and there are 6 trays. How many eggs are there altogether? Also, practice inverse division facts: $24 \div 8$</p> <p>Homework/spellings Please practise spellings and read through homework together before handing in.</p>
