Within this theme we will be covering the following subjects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ History - We will be exploring this time period, their technology and what life was like for people. ❖ Art- Creating mosaics inspired by Roman ones ❖ Geography - We will be learning about Italy and Rome. ❖ D&T - We will be looking at sculptures and making our own bust out of clay. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Science - Our first topic will be 'Light' where we will be looking at light and dark, reflections and sun safety.
