### **\*\*NEW\*\* Clothes & Brick-a-brac bank**



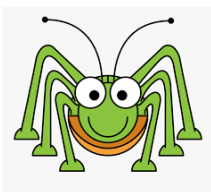

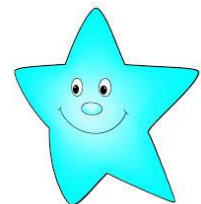
