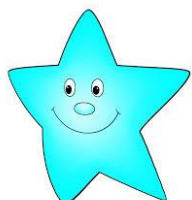
Snacks



Maths Morning

Dear Parents,

We would like to invite you in to see how maths is taught throughout the school, with an emphasis upon how we use resources to aid learning. With the introduction of maths fluency and mastery nearly 10 years ago and the expectation that children will be confident with applying taught skills and manipulating number with ease, many changes have occurred in the way in which we teach and use various resources in school.

On **Wednesday, 1st November**, straight after drop-off, we would encourage you to join us in the hall for a brief overview of how and when set methods are taught and the resources to support them, followed by the opportunity to see different resources being used in all classes by the teacher and children. This will be a short session in order for you to move between classes to see the various resources in action. There is no need to stick to seeing your own child, as the resources being used will be different in each class, allowing you to see how they aid children's understanding.
